As we end 2023, I want to acknowledge how you have supported this local throughout the year. Our achievements are noteworthy; we won first place among 52 locals in the 10<sup>th</sup> District. 553 has increased by 212%. A large wooden plaque, symbolizing our number one spot in growth, now hangs in the lobby of our local Union Hall. Each member of this local deserves congratulations for their loyalty and for proudly carrying our Union flag throughout this year. Thank you very much.

Our inside group has reached a significant milestone, achieving a wage of \$30, a goal we've anticipated for some time. We are committed to moving forward, not backward. Since my tenure began in 2016, we have more than doubled in size, growing from 250 members to nearly 650.


